

Introduction of SEU International Summer School Program

Theme : Nurturing Globally Competitive Talents through Chinese-Japanese Joint Online Teaching

Overview:

This project provides courses jointly offered by Chinese and Japanese universities with the purpose of co-cultivating globally competitive talents.

The project, taking the form of international joint teaching, offers lectures, discussions, cultural instructions and other activities, the topics of which include:

Course 1 Universities' International Education in the Internet Age;

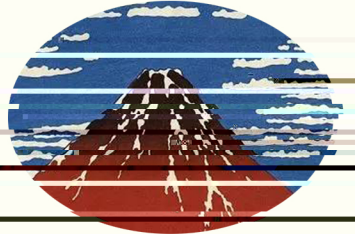
Course 2 - Discovery and Speculation.

New Trend of Chinese and Japanese Folklore;

Course 3 Progress of Geolinguistics and its Research;

Course 4 - 'Memory of Jiangsu's Cities' found in Japanese classics.

This summer school course, featuring cultural comparison and Frontier Academics, offers in-depth joint online courses in order to help students sense the social and cultural differences between China and Japan, promote mutual understanding, train cross-cultural communication skills, and enhance the exchange of Chinese and Japanese young students.



Schedule Description: July 5th (Monday) ~ July 9th (Friday)

A1- Opening Ceremony: The project leader and related personnel describe the online project and introduce the lecturing professors. Students of Southeast University and Japanese universities give self-introductions.

A2~A5: Special lectures for Chinese and Japanese university students. 4 courses to be offered (1 course a week).

A6: Making presentations to be rated by teachers.

B1~B5: Exchange of views on shared topics.

B6: Summary of students' presentations.

C1~C5: Social practices of Chinese and Japanese university students.

C6: Teachers summarize and confer certificates to international students.
